

 - Provincial supply management systems


On-Farm Food Safety

- CFC's On-Farm Food Safety Assurance Program
 - » On-Farm audits since 2001
 - » 100% farmers certified
 - » Mandatory in 10 provinces
 - » Full federal, provincial, territorial government recognition obtained in 2012




Animal Care

- > CFC's Animal Care Program
 - » Developed based on the Recommended Code of Practice
 - » On-farm audits since 2009
 - » 97%+ farmers certified
 - » Mandatory program
 - » Support for implementation from CVMA, CPEPC, FPPAC, CRFA, CFIG
- Support for National Farm Animal Care Council and Code of Practice




Antimicrobial Use & Resistance

- Coordinated Industry Strategy
 - » AMU & AMR surveillance
 - » Reduction strategies
 - Elimination of Category I preventive use
 - » Education of farmers
 - » Research
